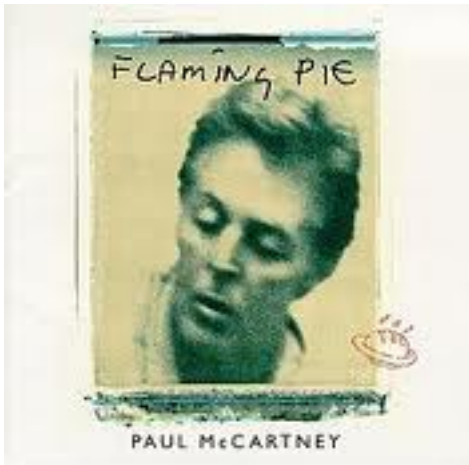


Paul McCartney's Flaming Pie
